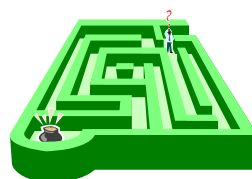


## Children's Views

Thanks to the council for giving us a large beech log! It will give lots of fun!



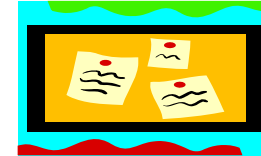
### Trees
